VigorFly 210 is a compact broadband router with 802.11n WLAN network. Its Ethernet WAN port can connect to VDSL/VDSL2/GPON/G.SHDSL /ADSL2+/ADSL/cable modem while you have fixed line. The NAT throughput can easily manage time-critical multimedia streaming. It's easy for family or friends to hook up PCs via embedded 10/100 Ethernet LAN switch to enjoy multimedia applications. Two antennas provide you with speedy WLAN networking. If you are out of coverage of fixed line, you can directly plug 3.5G USB modem to USB port on VigorFly 210. Or, you can use WiMAX USB modem with VigorFly 210. The sharing 3.5G / WiMAX/LTE connection accommodates adequate downstream/upstream capacity for residential needs.

- Support one VPN tunnel for dial in/out.
- Support QoS : Both traditional and APP QoS function.
- Support VoIP QoS function.
- Support APP QoS Monitor function.
- Support per IP bandwidth limit.
- Support per IP Session limit.
- Support SMS for WAN backup and reboot.
- Web server supports IPv6.
- Add Traffic Graph.

### Improvement

- Improved: IPv6 function improvement:
  - Support IPv6 WAN PPP / DHCPv6 / 6to4 mode.
  - Support IPv6 LAN DHCPv6 Server.
  - Support IPv6 firewall and remote management.

## Known Issue

- IPv6 https web server could not work with IE9 due to the problem of compatibility.
