

Release Note for VigorConnect

VigorConnect is a local network management software that provides centralized AP/switch management for LAN devices. VigorConnect has device status, monitor status of devices, or perform scheduling tasks such as firmware upgrade, configuration backup/restore and parameter profile for mass deployment of the managed devices.

New Features

- Support LDAP authentication for login.
- Support VigorAP 1062C (mesh setup not included).
- Support Host Overview on the page of Monitoring>>>Devices (note that Nmap is required for this feature).
- Add roles and permission control of users (for System Administrator, Operator and View Operator).

Improvement

- Improved: Support both “root” and “admin” accounts for accessing WUI in default. For the first time accessing VigorConnect, select to use root or admin as the login account.

Known Issue

- An issue that viewing Flow with FireFox (HTTPS) would block illegal HTTPS certificate issued by Grafana.
